This week we are discovering the meaning behind the parable of the lost coin.



Have you ever lost something precious to you? How did you feel? Did you spend time searching for it? Did you find the lost item?



Read Luke 15:8-10 and or watch the video

Jesus loved telling stories to get people thinking about what the kingdom of God is like and about how generous God's love is towards us.

How many coins did the woman have?
How many were lost?
What did the woman do to find the 1 she lost?
What did she do after she found it?

We are all very precious to God and He loves us and cares for us all individually. He loves all people, whether they are believers or not. He is actively looking for people who don't know him and wanting them to believe in him.
